GUIDED ADVENTURE

Discover Tomelloso

Welcome families to Tomelloso, ideal destination for families looking for culture, nature and leisure. It is a safe city, comfortable for walking or cycling, with numerous parks, playgrounds and educational activities for children. Its cultural heritage and wine-making tradition are combined with a hospitable atmosphere and a programme of events and festivities designed for children.

Visit a family-friendly winery

Wine is an essential part of Tomelloso's identity, and visiting one of its wineries allows families to delve into this tradition in a fun and educational way. Some wineries offer adapted guided tours, where adults and children can discover the wine-making process together, including a tour of the underground caves with their enormous clay jars.

Nearby natural environment: Peñarroya Castle and Lagunas de Ruidera

A medieval fortress next to the reservoir of the same name, perfect for a short excursion where children can explore and learn history through play. To round off the day, the Lagunas de Ruidera, just 30 minutes away, offer trails, swimming areas, nature activities and unique landscapes. This natural park is a very popular destination for families, as it combines adventure, learning and direct contact with the environment.

Play and learn

Places such as the Constitución Park, with its slides, swings and picnic areas, or the Urbano Martínez Park, with tennis courts and ping-pong tables, as well as space for skating, invite you to spend hours of fun outdoors.

For its part, the Virgen de las Viñas Park offers a playground, picnic areas and easy routes for walking or cycling in the heart of nature. Also noteworthy are La Paz Park, Europa Park, close to the former, and Ramón Ugena Promenade, all of which have children's play areas where the little ones can play while their parents relax.



Los Portales Inn

An old inn converted into a cultural centre and tourist office. At the entrance to the lift, to the left of the kitchen, you can see an original stone plaque carved with the year of construction of the inn, 1778. Upstairs, there is a terrace with views over the entire Plaza de España. Discover Tomelloso in a fun way!

Antonio López Torres Museum

Ideal for introducing children to art in a simple and visual way, displaying works by local painters reflecting the landscape and life of La Mancha. After the visit, you can enjoy the playground in the Glorieta, where the museum is located.

Constitución Park

This is the municipality's large green space, perfect for enjoying with the family. With children's games, a zip line, swings and areas for all ages, it offers a safe and pleasant environment. Its paths are ideal for walking or cycling, resting in the shade or having a picnic. Its central location and peaceful atmosphere make it an ideal place to unwind and share quality time with the family.

Museum of Carts and Farming Implements

A unique museum where children can learn about rural life in La Mancha, exploring traditional carts, tools and agricultural machinery. Among its most striking features is an impressive shelter, built entirely of stones, which was used to provide shelter during work in the fields. This shelter is made of more than 2,000,000 stones!

Hermitage of the Virgen de las Viñas

Just 4 km from Tomelloso, in the Pinilla area, it offers an ideal natural setting for a family day out, with pine forests, a children's playground, barbecue areas and picnic areas. This is the starting point for the bombos hiking trail, which can be explored on foot or by bicycle, with routes suitable for different ages and levels. An activity combining nature, history and physical exercise in the heart of La Mancha.
