Shopping Streets in the Centre

The heart of Tomelloso's shopping district is located in the most central streets: Calle Reverendo Eliseo Ramírez (the popular "Bethlehem Street"), Calle Don Víctor Peñasco ("La Feria Street"), next to Independencia and Doña Crisanta. Plaza de España, with its terraces and shop windows. Here you will find a wide range of products: fashion, footwear, jewellery, shops selling local products and souvenirs, as well as numerous restaurants and bars.

- ▶ Weekly Market: held on Mondays at the fairgrounds (Calle Ángel Luis Cabañas), with stalls selling food, clothing, accessories, local products and flowers. End-of-
- ▶ Season Market: held in September on Las Moreras promenade (Calle D. Víctor Peñasco), with a festive atmosphere and great deals.

Retail gala: with discounts, raffles, children's entertainment, DJs and live music. A perfect day for shopping and family fun in June.

Plan your shopping day

Regular hours:

Mornings from 10:00 to 14:00 and afternoons from 17:00 to 20:00 (may vary depending on the season).

Suggested itinerary:

Start at Plaza de España (shopping + tour of Independencia and Calle Don Víctor Peñasco). Stop at the Wholesale Market for a tapa or coffee. In the afternoon, cultural visit and souvenir shopping. End the day enjoying dinner at one of the city's restaurants.

Wide pedestrian streets, accessible for pushchairs and people with reduced mobility.

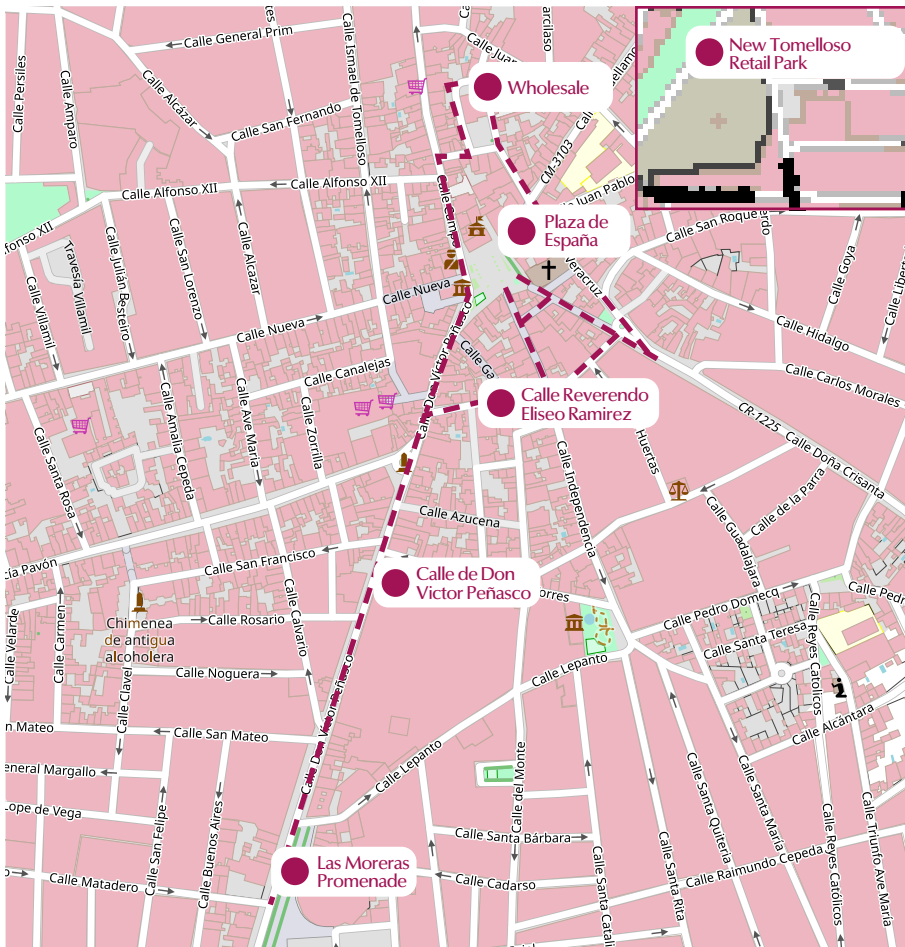
Additional Resources and Practical Tips
