First-class sports infrastructure

Tomelloso Sports Complex

More than 200,000 m² dedicated to sports and active leisure:

- ▶ Main pavilion (1,200 spectators), gym and indoor pelota court.
- ▶ Swimming pools: heated 25 x 16.5 m, 50 m Olympic pool and teaching pools.
- ▶ Tennis and paddle tennis area: 4 paddle tennis courts and 3 tennis courts.
- ▶ Olympic velodrome.
- ▶ Multi-sport courts (indoor football, volleyball), skateboarding, pétanque, caliche and beach volleyball court. Indoor running track, large gardens and picnic areas.

Paco Gálvez Municipal Stadium

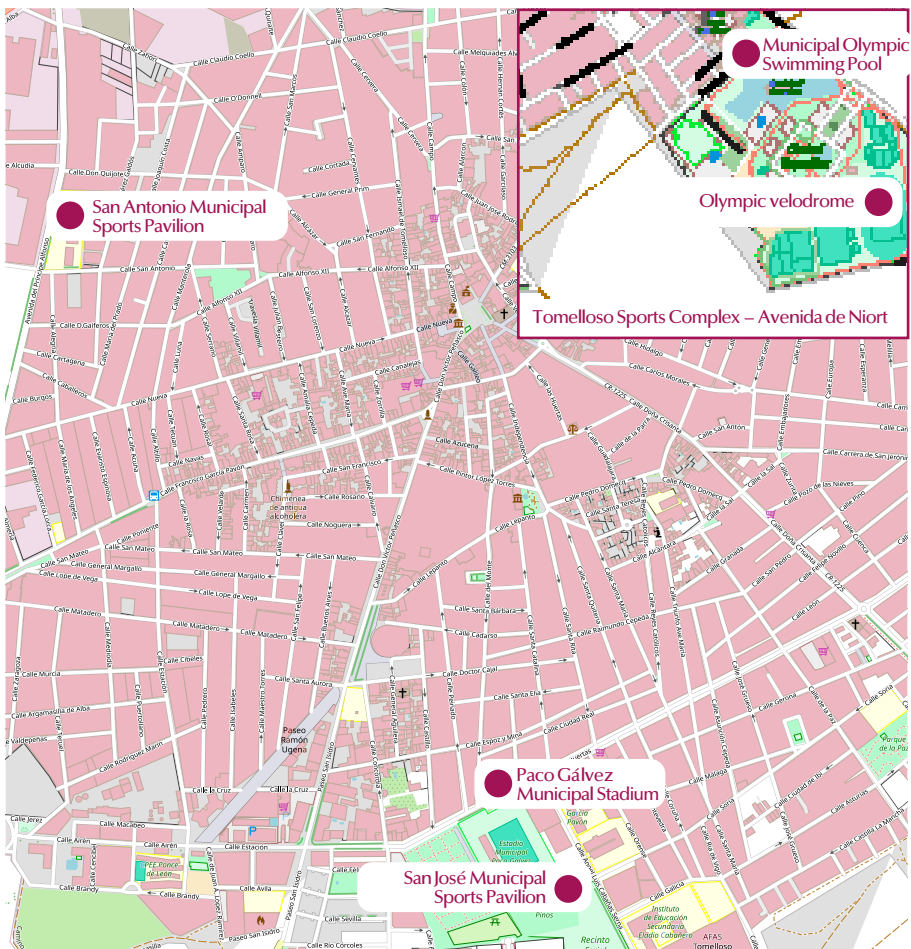
